Editorial

2025 : A Year of Change

Some years mark a turning point in the life of an institution. Not because its purpose changes, but because its work begins to operate at a different scale. For the Bandaranaike Academy for Leadership and Public Policy, 2025 was such a year.

Alongside its core teaching and research activities, the Academy crossed several institutional thresholds. BALPP convened its first international conference in collaboration with Sciences Po- France, bringing international academic exchange into its public policy work. It held its first Awards Ceremony, recognising academic excellence and contribution within its growing community. The Academy also entered into direct collaboration with the Parliament of Sri Lanka, extending its engagement from classrooms and publications into the formal structures of governance.

These moments did not stand apart from the rest of the year. They emerged from work already underway. Programs were delivered, policy writing expanded its reach, and public conversations continued to test ideas against experience. What changed was not direction, but depth. The Academy's work began to connect more visibly across institutions, disciplines, and audiences.

This newsletter offers a selective account of that year. It traces how BALPP's activities in 2025 moved between education, research, and public engagement, and how those strands increasingly reinforced one another. The intention is not to catalogue everything that occurred, but to reflect a year in which the Academy's role became clearer through action rather than assertion.

In 2026, the Bandaranaike Academy for Leadership and Public Policy will build on the institutional ground secured over the past year. The focus will be on deepening the quality of its programs, strengthening its research and publications, and expanding collaboration with public institutions and international partners.

Scales of Governance was Sri Lanka's largest international academic and public conference in 2025, bringing together global and local experts to engage on governance, leadership, and public policy. It took place on 22–23 July 2025 at the Bandaranaike Memorial International Conference Hall (BMICH) in Colombo, Sri Lanka. **The event was jointly organised by the BALPP and Sciences Po of France, and it convened scholars, analysts, and practitioners from across the region to examine evolving governance dynamics, democratic processes, decentralisation, and local government challenges in South Asian contexts.**



The conference addressed a defining challenge confronting contemporary democracies in South Asia – the growing strain between decision making at the centre and governance outcomes at provincial, municipal, and community levels.



Scales of Governance 2025 created a rare space to examine how authority and accountability interact across different layers of the state, moving beyond abstract theory to institutional realities. In doing so, it contributed to a clearer understanding of why governance systems succeed or fail, offering insights of direct relevance to policymakers and scholars.


